

## NCAPHA SEEKING OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST

NCAPHA is recruiting for a full-time Occupational Therapist to be placed in the Harnett County Health Department. Position would administer skilled care to housebound patients.

### Duties to include:

- Evaluate patient's/client's functional status. Evaluates home environment for hazards or barriers to more independent living. Identifies equipment needs. Participates in the development of the total plan of care.
- Develop treatment program and establishes goals for improved function.
- May teach new skills or retrain patient/client in once familiar daily activities that have been lost due to illness or injury.
- Maintain contact/communication with other personnel involved in the patient's/client's care.
- Identify patient's family/caregiver needs for other home health services and refers as appropriate.

Candidates must possess strong communication and organizational skills as well as current CPR certification. Also required is current North Carolina Occupational Therapy license and graduation from an accredited Occupational Therapy program.
