Description: Provide clinical and educational services to residents of Orange County. Responsibilities include the following: dental screenings, prophylaxis, application of preventive services, exposing and processing radiographs, developing and conducting dental health education programs, supervising and evaluating dental hygiene students from UNC School of Dentistry. This position will also serve as the Community Dental Care Coordinator serving clients age 0-5 and their families through the Smart Start Dental Preschool Screening and Education Program three days per week and providing clinical and educational services to prenatal clients two days per week.

Work Schedule: Monday through Friday, 8:00 am – 5:00 pm. Flex schedule will be arranged so the person in this position can conduct after hour dental programs in the community.

Requirements: Requires any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from an accredited college or university with a degree in dental hygiene; or graduation from an approved two-year program of dental hygiene and two years experience in dental hygiene, dental health education or equivalent. Must be licensed to practice as a dental hygienist in North Carolina. Bilingual applicants with fluency in Spanish and English are encouraged to apply.
