POSITION TITLE: PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE II – Women’s Health Coordinator
LOCATION: Stokes Family Health Center, Danbury, N.C.
STARTING SALARY: \$37,098.00 (Annually) – Commensurate with experience
CLOSING DATE: Open until filled.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Plan and manage the Women's Health Program. This position will also be responsible for establishing clinic goals, policies, procedures under the direction of the Health Director and Nursing Supervisor. Must have the ability and experience to make independent decisions in a clinical setting and provide supervision to lower level personnel. The applicant will be required to have, (or be willing to learn and acquire) a complete understanding of public health concepts. Work also involves working clinics on assigned clinic days, to include but not limited to, application of nursing skills, teaching and supportive counseling with patients with multiple health and psychosocial problems.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from a four-year college or university with a B.S. Degree in Nursing which includes a Public Health Nursing rotation and one year of Public Health Nursing experience; or graduation from an accredited school of professional nursing and two years of professional nursing experience including one year in public health; or an equivalent combination of training and experience.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS: A current license to practice as a Registered Nurse in North Carolina by the N.C. Board of Nursing and a valid North Carolina Driver's License. Also, requires the use of a personal car.
